MARRIAGE ENRICHMENT WEEKEND IN KNOCK.

Marriage Encounter has been serving married couples in Ireland since 1972. Primary service is a Marriage Enrichment Week a residential retreat designed to enrich and revitalize stable marriages through improved communication. Couples are introduced to a simple but profound technique of loving communication, known as "dialogue", which supports intimacy, mutual understanding, and responsible living. The weekend offers couples a safe and sacred space, away from the distractions of daily life, where spouses can privately reflect on their feelings, hopes, and dreams. Guided presentations are delivered by three experienced married couples and a Catholic priest, who share personal testimonies to gently invite participants to reflect on their own relationship. Importantly, the weekend is privacy-focused: there is no group sharing, and all reflection and dialogue take place solely between husband and wife. The upcoming weekend will take place at [St Mary's Retreat Centre, Knock, Co. Mayo](#), and is open to all couples married in the Catholic Church, regardless of how long they have been married.
